- 1. The meeting was called to order at 7:01 am by Chair Dan Farnworth.

 - A. Madeline reported we received 3.51" precipitation. Saw several flights of geese. No more turkey vultures, more hawks. Pond is still getting higher.
 - B. Tom would like access to the storage unit. Noted a need to digitize old minutes.
 - C. Dan received a notice from SDAO about a major weather event coming in the next few days. Possible flooding?
 - D. Madeline reported the city (Monmouth) is working on trimming trees under power lines, etc.

7. Reports

A. Finance

- Monthly Report. Andrea has been sending bank statements to Gloria who will be putting together a financial statement. Cash: LGIP: \$329,467.29; PTB: \$5,517.64. Checks: #2206, Johnson \$400; #2207, SDAO \$135; #2208 Ascension \$198. Discussion of Ascension invoices; Andrea clarified amounts prior to issuing check. Andrea will send Ascension phone number to Karin.

- C. Nutria. Ed reported: 6 caught, 52 traps out. Discussion of nutria near IES; Dan will check into.
- D. Engineer's Report. Todd:
 - a. Dallas, old Weyerhauser site has 2 pipes that connect into a larger pipe; there is serious discussion to remove pipes, have large stormwater detention upstream. City of Dallas also doing LOMR along old Pragetzer property north of Monmouth cutoff, west of Godsey. Andrea asked about possible removal of buildings; Todd didn't think there were any in that location.

b. Spray contractor did not get weather window to line up with this schedule; the next spray will be spring. Discussion of vegetation sprayed. Madeline asked about the new retention pond built at Ash Creek Station.
